

The Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and the United Church of Christ are responding to an urgent request from the National Council of Churches in Korea (NCCK), a longtime mission partner of Global Ministries, to join with them in supporting the Korea Peace Appeal in calling for a formal, official end to the Korean War.

Disciples have been asked to collect 10,000 signatures supporting the Korea Peace Appeal, and Disciples Peace Fellowship has committed to collecting at least 1000 of those signatures!
